If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organizer's decision.
Competition System	EJU / IJF system – KO with double repechage

Competition systems with less than 5 competitors will be played in Round Robin:

Competition systems with low number of participants:

- 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide

- 3,4,5 entries: round robin competition system (Information on round robin rules can be found on the EJU General Handbook on the EJU Website, Downloads section)

- 6 and more entries: repechage competition system.

Weigh-in The weigh-in will take place in the morning on each day of the event, at the OFFICIAL HOTELS, according to the attached Program. Athletes must present accreditation card and passport or national identity card with photo.

Referees All team must be accompanied by one maximum 2 IJF referee A or B which is one condition to participate in this tournament to meet the requirements of EJU requirements. Organising Committee will cover cost full board accommodation for three days for 10 IJF A or B licenced referees. We can not accepte more then 10 referees for free accomodation.

Seeding of 4 Top athletes in each weight category according to the EJU Senior Ranking List. In case of 2 athletes from the same country in the Top 4, The athletes will be seperated by Nations.

Ranking list EJU Senior Ranking List is complied with points won from each Tournament in the EJU Senior Ranking List.

Entries

First entry

National Federations are requested to inform the Judo Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina whether they will participate in the tournament or not by prescribed entry form not later than February 15th 2012.

Final entry

Each federation will have to send to the Judo federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina the very precise composition of its delegation (enclosed form) by March 25th 2012. No limit of participants per category.

Jumas inscription According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday of the week of the Tournament. . Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. Jumas membership must then be ordered through the federation. Jumas website : <https://jumas12.net/user/login>

Entry fee National judo federations have to pay entry fee 30 € for each competitor. Payable to the Organizing Committee.

Transfer Federations which reserve rooms in the official hotels of competition can make use of all transportation. They will be picked up at the airport or train station and after competition transferred back to the airport or train station. Federation not staying in official hotels can't use transportation.

Liability Neither the organisers of the event, nor the Judo Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (nor any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with this tournament. For nations, who need VISA to enter Bosnia and Herzegovina, please send to us as soon as possible (latest 1st March 2012) the list of participants with names, passport numbers, birth dates and function.

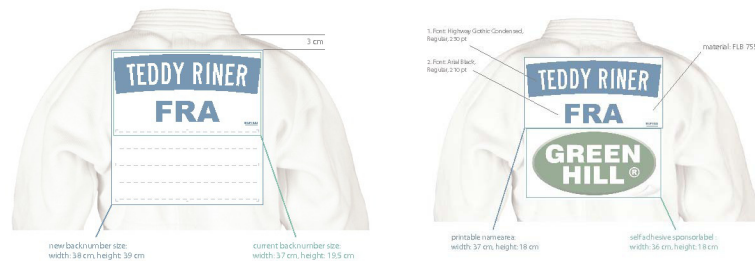
Back Number

Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number

The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes with out the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, no reserve Judogis will be available

The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
