- Weigh-in:** Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100 g will be allowed for their weight category limits.
Athletes must present accreditation card and passports or national identity card with photo.
- Weigh-in-venue:** Unofficial and official weigh-in will take place at “Holiday Inn Berlin City East”, Landsberger Allee 203 in 13055 Berlin (700 m from the competition hall).

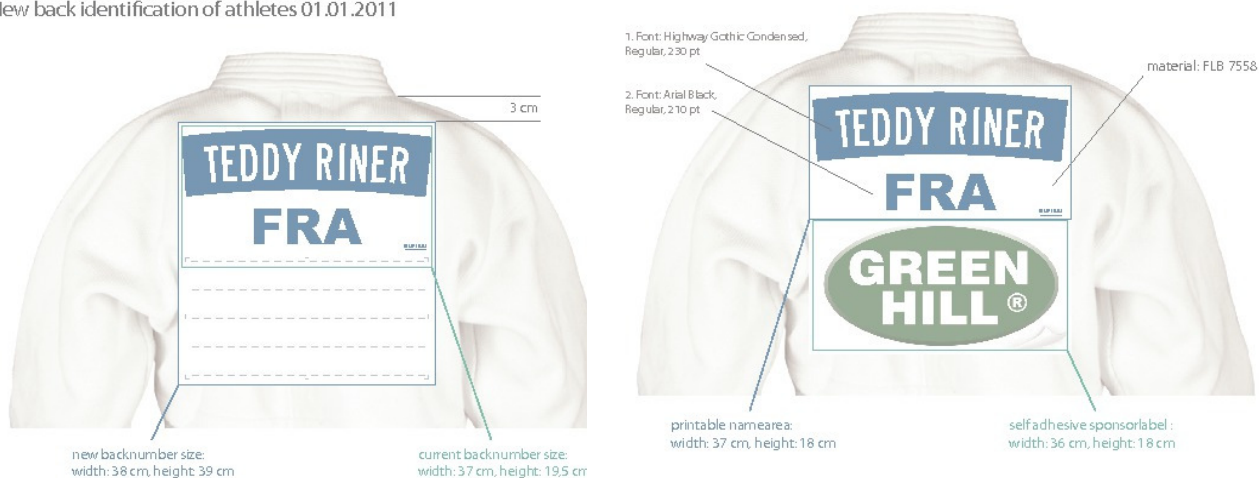
- Contest System:** Double repechage competition system
Competition systems with low number of participants:
2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide
3, 4, 5 entries: one pool competition system (Information on round robin rules can be found on the EJU General Handbook on the EJU Website, Downloads section)
6 and more entries: repechage competition system
Time of contests: 4 min / Golden Score 2 min
Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition.
Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.
- Refereeing:** Each delegation should bring an IJF/ Continental license referee.
Referee's meeting will take place on Saturday, 05th of May at 09:00 h.
- Entries:** Nominal entries are to be sent to the German Judo Federation until March, 20th.
According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday of the week of the Tournament, 30th April 2012
Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. Jumas membership must then be ordered through the federation.

Judogi: Blue & White Judogi are obligatory, they have to fulfil the requirements of the EJU; Judogi control according to Sokuteiki rule!

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available.
3. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
