5. Age

15 years old and over (Born in 2000 and before)

6. Responsibility of the Federations

The competitors will compete under full responsibility of their federations. Each national federation is responsible for insuring its judoka against "injury and third part risk (public liability)" during the period of the camp and travelling in connection with this event. The Organizers, European Judo Union and Russian Judo Federation declines all responsibility.

7. Facilities

In addition to randori sessions the running track and other possibilities such as swimming pool, sauna, gym are available inside the Olympic Training Center in Sochi.

Please note:

- The number of single rooms is very limited.
- Check-in is not earlier than 12.00 p.m., otherwise an additional night will be charged, check-out is not later than 12.00 p.m., otherwise an additional night will be charged.
- All participants of the camp should stay at the official hotel – booked through the organizer.
- Delegates accommodated in unofficial hotel will pay an accreditation fee of 100€/ person.
- In case of any damage to hotel property or training venue caused by members of a delegation, their national federation will be charged by the organizing committee

11. EJU Supported Athletes

The athletes of all EJU Support Lists should be required to confirm their participation by sending a completed Application Forms to the organizers.

The athletes of all EJU Support Lists will be accommodated in double room with full board without any additional charge. The cost for upgrade like accommodation in single rooms has to be paid by the supported athlete / his (her) National Federation to organizers at registration: 20€ person / night.

The federations / athletes will cover all other expenses as travel, insurance, the EJU OTC Fee (see #4), etc.
