Competition mode	<p>Competition will be carried out according to the EJU / IJF official rules using the double repechage system.</p> <p>Time of fights: 4 min. Golden Score: 2 min.</p> <p>The white and blue judogi are obligatory in this competition.</p> <p>Preliminaries – 3 mats (8m x 8m) Finals – 1 mat (8m x 8m)</p>
Refereeing Rules	<p>Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition.</p> <p>Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.</p>
Referees	<p>All invited National Delegation are kindly requested to bring one A or B referee. All referees will be covered by Organizing Committee from the 8th of January(dinner) till the 11th of January 2010 (breakfast).</p>
Draw	<p>The draw will be held on Friday 8th of January at 19:00hrs at Hotel 'Rus'. There is no seeding for Cadet European Cups.</p>
EJU Cadet Ranking List	<p>An EJU Cadet Ranking List is compiled with points won from each tournament.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each year this ranking list starts from zero- no points are transferred from year to year. • The only purpose of the ranking list is seeding at the draw of the EC Cadets. <p>Based on the previous year statistics, there are two levels of the Cadet European Cups. This tournament is rated as a <u>top level tournament</u>. The points scale for the EJU Cadet RL is set up accordingly.</p>

<p>Back Number</p>	<p>Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number is made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.</p> <p>The fixed part of the back number must be the official EJU / IJF one, which should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.</p> <p>The EJU back numbers are obligatory for all EJU Official Events: European Championships and European Cups for U17, U20, U23, Seniors and Veterans, and World Cups organized in the territory of the EJU. <u>No athletes will be allowed to compete without the EJU / IJF Official Name and Country patch, the athlete will not be allowed to compete.</u></p>	<p>The diagram shows a blue judogi back with a white patch.
