	The points scale for the EJU Junior Ranking List is set up accordingly
Liability	Neither the organizers of the event or the Ukrainian Judo Federation (or any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury, nor for any loss or damage of property in connection with the trip and participation on this tournament and training camp
Back Number	<p>1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.</p> <p>2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.</p> <p>3. The CHANGEABLE part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.</p>
Entries	<p>IMPORTANT</p> <p>Numerical inscriptions The numerical inscriptions must arrive to the organisers not later than the 5th of April 2010. The sponsor back numbers are ordered according to this inscription. A fine will be imposed if the federation registers an unrealistic number or does not send in the inscription</p> <p>Nominal inscriptions The nominal inscriptions must be entered into JUMAS (deadline 30 December) http://europejudo.com/jumas/ The nominal inscriptions and travel plan must be sent to organizing committee, by e-mail, till the 01 of May 2010. Closing date for entries 01 of May 2010.</p>
Registration fee	All payment for Hotel booking by cash on arrival in Accreditation Centre – HOTEL “RUS”
Training camp	Training camp will be organized after the tournament from 17th to 20th of May 2010 in “Covered Tennis Courts”
