### Monday, 1<sup>st</sup> March:

Departure of participants (departure to Spala Training Camp as well)

## Participation limit:

According to the IJF rules:

- Per country: 4 competitors maximum per weight category
- Organizing country: 4 competitors maximum per weight category

## Competition mode:

Tournament will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF, the competition system KO with **quarterfinals** (last 8) **repechage on 3 mats**.

- eliminatory rounds and repechage 3 mats (8 m x 8 m)
- fights for 3<sup>rd</sup> places 2 mats (8 m x 8 m)
- finals 1 mat (8 m x 8 m)

Seeding of the top 8 among entered competitors according to the World Ranking List. Rest of the draw – separation by nations.

## Judogis:

The blue and white judogis will be obligatory.

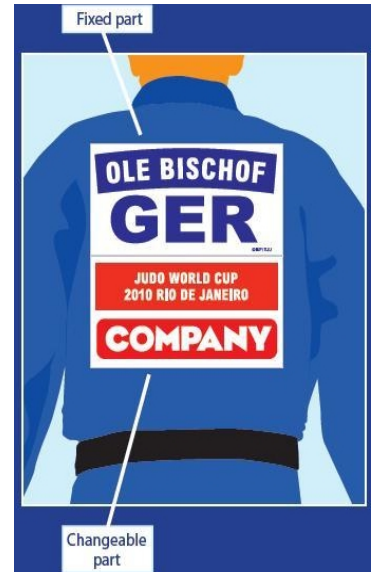
Judogi control according to Sokuteiki Rule approved by IJF from the 1st January 2009.

All competitors are obliged to have back numbers on their judo:

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the **FIXED** upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the **CHANGEABLE** bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.

2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the **FIXED** part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from [www.mybacknumber.com](http://www.mybacknumber.com). Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.

3. The organizer will deliver the **CHANGEABLE** part during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.



## Doping control:

According to EJU rules:

**Extract from EJU Handbook:** The gold medal winner and another drawn medalists from the rest (TWO tests PER WEIGHT CATEGORY contested).

## Referees:

**Maximum per country:**

- Organizing nation: 4 referees
- Participating nation: 1 referees

Referees must hold the IJF licenses - A or B.

Friday 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2009 at 19:00 in Hotel NOVOTEL.

**Financial Conditions:** All staying expenses of participants will be covered by visiting federations. Stay expenses must be paid by transfer to Polish Judo Association bank account.

**Attention:** Official hotel NOVOTEL must be booked **exclusively through the Polish Judo Association** on the enclosed form, or above full rates paid to organizer.

**Accreditation fee:** **Those who will not stay in official hotels must pay organizing expenses of 100 EUR per person. These fees will be collected during the accreditation.**

**Travel expenses:** Participating National Federations are responsible for their own travel to Warsaw.

**Transportation:** The prices include transfers from / to the Warsaw airport Okęcie or railway station Warszawa Centralna and transportation in Warsaw concerning the tournament but only for those who pay stay expenses.

**Payment:** Kindly complete the payment before **12<sup>th</sup> February, 2010** to our bank account.  
All bank fees and money transfer costs must be covered by the participating federation.  
In case of payment for accommodation after the deadline or on the spot, 10% charge will be added to the expenses.

**Cancellation:**

- Up to 30 days before arrival: free of charge
- Between 29 – 15 days before arrival: 50% refund
- Less than 15 days: no refund.

**EJU fee:** EJU Inscription fee for the World Cup must be paid for each athlete: **10 € /athlete** . This fee will be collected in cash during the registration.

**Accreditation:** All participants and officials should be registered in Jumas. The accreditation will take place at the official hotel based on official program.

**Advertisements:**

Regulation of EJU concerning advertisements on judogis are obliged. During the tournaments back numbers on the judogis provided by the organizer are allowed only. Back numbers of previous tournaments must be replaced by the back numbers of the tournament.

The judogis will be given **upon arrival** to the Polish Judo Association reception and the back numbers will be sewn on.

**Visa:**

For nations who need a VISA to enter POLAND, please send us as soon as possible visa application form (latest January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010). For detailed information contact Polish Embassy in your country.

**Liability:**

The organizers of the event and the Polish Judo Association (or any of its officials or members) will **not** be liable or responsible for arising accident or damage during participation (competition and training sessions) or traveling in connection with this World Cup. **Each delegation must assume full responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities and assistance repatriation for their competitors and officials during their stay in Poland.**
