§ 3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin).

§ 6 and more entries: double repechage competition system

age 15-19 (born in 1991-1995)

8. Judogi

Blue & White Judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteiki rule

9. Back numbers

Please note that the new back identification of athletes is compulsory in all IJF/EJU events from the 1st January 2010. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the new back Fixed Identification will not be allowed to compete, no exceptions permitted.

If, by the Jumas deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.

16. Weight-in

Official weight-in on Saturday and Sunday at 08:00.-09:00. In Hotel Dorpat

17. Transfer

Organiser will provide transport from and to Tallinn and Tartu Airport, Tallinn Port and Tallinn and Tartu railway station only if the transport schedule is provided to the organiser latest before the 15th of March. There will be a transportation between the hotel and sport hall.

18. Liability

19. Awards
