**Number of participants**

Maximum number of participants: 5 athletes, 5 substitutes (1 substitute is authorized per each weight category), 1 coach, 1 representative.

**Age of participants**

The competitions are held between men teams. The participants must be 30+.

**Weight categories**

Competitions take place in the following weight categories: -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, +90kg.

At the accreditation and the weigh-in athletes show their official documents: passport, **service ID or military ID, or an IPA card**. Please note: Athletes who are or were included in national teams of judo or sambo (2017- 2019 for foreign teams, 2016-2019 for Russian teams) are not allowed to participate.

**Competition System**

The competitions are held according to the Olympic system with the repechage from semi-finalists. The contestants are divided into two tables: "A"- Foreign teams, "B" - Russian teams. Teams which lose semi-finals compete for bronze medals in their own respective table.

The competitions will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU.

**Judogi**

Judogis must comply with IJF Sokuteiki Rules. On the draw sheet the team/athlete on top wears a white Judogi and the one below wears a blue Judogi.

Markings on the Judogi must comply with EJU Judogi Rules and athletes must have the official backnumber (to be ordered from [www.mybacknumber.com](http://www.mybacknumber.com) or [www.ijfbacknumber.com](http://www.ijfbacknumber.com)).

**If the judogi does not meet the demands of both EJU and IJF including the name and country patch, the athlete will be disqualified.**
