PARTICIPATION	Boys and Girls born in 1994 and 1995. In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser’s decision. If, by the Jumas deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned. Each country can enter maximum 4 athletes per category.

COMPETITIN MODE	<p>Competition will be carried out according to the EJU / IJF official rules using the double repechage system.</p> <p>Time of fights: 4 min. Golden Score: 2 min.</p> <p>The white and blue judogi are obligatory in this competition.</p> <p>Preliminaries – 3 mats (8m x 8m) Finals – 1 mat (8m x 8m)</p> <p>Competition systems with low number of participants: 2 entries: beter of 2 fights, if 1-1 the tihrd match will decide. 3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system. 6 and more entries : quarter –final (last 8) repechage or double repechage competition system .</p>
REFEREEING RULES	<p>Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes tries to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition.</p> <p>Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.</p>
REFEREES	<p>All are invited National Delegation are kindly requested to bring one A or B referee. The accomodation Costs of IJF A-B referees will be covered by organizing committe from Friday, 19th of March, 2010 (dinner) to Monday,22nd of March 2010 (breakfast)</p>
DRAW	<p>The draw will be held on Friday 19th of March 2010 at 19:00hrs at Hotel ‘Sport’. There is no seeding for Cadets European Cup.</p>
LIABILITY	<p>Neither the organizers of the event nor the Turkish Judo Federation (or any of its officials or members) will be responsible for any personal injury, any loss or damage of property in connection with the trip and participation on this tournament and training camp.</p>
BACK NUMBER	<p>Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number is made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.
