3. Regulations to minimize COVID-19 related risks

Anyone not complying with the conditions of participation described in these outlines will not be eligible to take part in the event and will be subject to disciplinary action.

The fundamental principle throughout all EJU events during the Covid-19 era is to protect and be protected by wearing a mask, sanitising, distancing and respecting the recommendations of the EJU protocol. All participants have the mutual responsibility to protect one-another.

Each National Federation delegation participant (athlete, coach, team official, physiotherapist, doctor, President etc.) must have read and understood the latest version of the Protocol for resuming IJF events during the Covid-19 pandemic which can be found here: covid.ijf.org.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **Each National Federation taking part must nominate a Covid-19 Manager who is fluent in English.**
- **There can only be ONE (1) COVID-19 MANAGER PER FEDERATION!**

Before Travelling

1. Check if you need a visa, and if yes - request it from the organiser. Please send a good quality passport copy (PDF) and filled in Visa Application form by email: events@judoaustria.at. Please, see visa form uploaded.

2. Book accommodation and send a detailed rooming list. Last minute changes can be accommodated whilst the delegation waits in the bus or outside the hotel.

3. Present on arrival: 1 PCR which is not older than 96 hours or 1 laboratory antigen test not older than 72 hours (no matter vaccinated or not).

During the period when the test is done you should stay isolated and limit contact with other people as much as possible. If you experience any kind of symptoms do not start to travel (even with negative test).

4. Present upon arrival IJF Liability Release Waiver which is uploaded to my.ijf.org once and is valid through the whole year 2023. The document can be found under the link: <https://www.ijf.org/covid19/2663> and on EJU homepage for every event.

5. **PCR test and Liability Release Waiver must be uploaded to the platform my.ijf.org by NF administrator well in advance BEFORE TEAM ARRIVAL.**

6. Enter all participants in the IJF registration system Judobase. Registration in Judobase is obligatory for all participants of the training camp.

Entering Austria

The following must be brought/at hand for border control:

1. Passport, ID, and applicable visas, as required

- All regular border-crossing regulations must be followed regarding the validity of passports and visas, as applicable for each respective country
- Border control officers will check documents (passports or other documents that contain similar information to those in passport)

Entering the event

1. Upon entering the official hotel rapid antigen test will be done. If RAT is positive - PCR will be done to confirm positivity.

The tests will be held at the **Nationalparkzentrum Mittersill**

2. Cost of the tests: **100 €** PCR and **40 €** rapid antigen which has to be paid by the participating federation prior the arrival.

Throughout your stay

1. Within the bubble 2 subgroups will be created: male teams and female teams (according to numbers of participation).

2. Wash/sanitise your hands regularly, especially if you have had contact with a person or an object. Competitors should wash and disinfect their hands and feet regularly, especially before the warm-up and the training.

3. Mask wearing is optional*, unless it is mandated by the host country's government with the exceptions of: competing/refereeing/coaching/medal ceremonies, on/at the Field of Play tatami, on the warm-up tatami whilst warming up or on the training tatami whilst training, or while eating in designated dining areas.

4. Submit yourselves to contactless temperature measurement by the organiser on arrival at the point of entry in the country, at accommodation premises, throughout the training camp to be accepted by all accredited population.

Anyone registering a high temperature will be asked to remain outside and their delegation COVID-19 Manager and the LOC COVID-19 Manager will be contacted. An opportunity to recheck their temperature will be given, if it is still high a final decision will be made by the LOC COVID-19 Manager.

In case of positive result

Each case will be consulted with the local epidemiological authorities.

Quarantine period: 5-10 days depending on vaccination status

Quarantine hotel: **Same hotel of booked accommodation.**

Anyone with a positive test **MUST** stay in the quarantine hotel provided by the organiser. The cost must be paid by the National Federation.

Insurance

It is the responsibility of the National Federation to ensure that in addition to their normal insurance they have sufficient insurance in place to cover any COVID-19-related costs. The organiser of the event and the EJU accept no liability for any claims relating to cancellation of the event due to COVID-19 or medical costs for any COVID-19 related illness that may affect a National Federation delegation member during the event.

Symptoms after arrival

Anyone who experiences symptoms after arrival must immediately contact their Team COVID-19 Manager

5. Participation

EJU/IJF Member Federations can participate at the OTC. The numbers of athletes participating in the EJU OTC may be limited.

7. EJU Participation Fee

30 € per participating athlete.

8. Age

15 years old and over (Born in 2008 and before).

9. Responsibility of the Federations

The athletes will train under the full responsibility of their National Federations. Each National Federation is responsible for insuring its judoka against 'injury and third part risk (public liability)' during the period of the camp. The European Judo Union and Hungarian Judo Association decline all responsibility.

10. Accreditation

At least one team delegate (and not more than 2) who have been tested on spot and received negative results must attend the accreditation **on Sunday, January 8th 2023 starting from 14:00 and on Monday, January 9th 2023 (10:00-19:00) at Nationalparkzentrum Mittersill**. To confirm the entries of all athletes and officials and accommodation payment.

Very important: Each National Federation must be represented by a team leader or coach responsible for registration of ALL athletes from the respective National Federation, regardless club or other membership. Every National Federation will be accepted for accreditation only once, when all entries and payments can be confirmed at the same time.

11. Facilities

Tatami will be approx. 1400 m² and training will be performed in two groups. The use of the indoor pool at Sporthotel Kogler is included in the price for all participants. Further, participants can also use the wellness-area and the ski resort "Kitzbühel AG" at reduced prices.

12. Transport

13. Accommodation

Hotels in 3 different categories are offered. A minimum stay of 4 nights is obligatory. Prices are per person and per night including bed & breakfast in single or double rooms or apartments. Meals can only be added for the whole period (e.g. only lunch and/or dinner for all days).

Reservations will be processed according to the date of your booking. In case your chosen category is fully booked, you will be informed and requested to make a new reservation.

Check-out not later than 11:00 am, otherwise an additional night will be charged. Full board is starting with dinner on the day of arrival, and ending with lunch on the day of your departure.

In case of any damage to hotel property or training venue caused by members of a delegation, their National Federation will be charged by the organizing committee.

Judoka and Officials who are not staying at the official accommodations have to pay 200€/person in addition to EJU Participation fee.

14. Cancellation policy

Replacements (same hotel booking, different name) are free of charge.

30 days (or more) before accreditation day:	no cancellation costs
29-15 days before accreditation day:	50% refund
Cancellations within 14 days (or less) before accreditation day:	no refund

15. Payment

To confirm your entry, kindly complete the payment for accommodation before **23rd of December 2022** to our bank account. All bank fees and money transfer costs must be paid by the sender federation.

In general, **no cash payments** are allowed (in exceptional cases it can be agreed on bilateral basis between LOC and NF). Credit cards cannot be accepted on spot.
