3. Important Information

Before Travelling

Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of arrival.

- Check host country entry requirements and airline requirements (if applicable).
- Check if you need a visa, and if yes, request it from the LOC according to the details in the **ENTERING THE HOST COUNTRY** section.

- Send travel information (arrival and departures) to the LOC.
- Book accommodation with the LOC.
- Upload a signed individual IJF Liability Release Waiver 2023 to my.ijf.org
- The form can be found at: covid.ijf.org or in EJU Calendar for the respective event.

Entering host country

Each individual is responsible to ensure they follow the entry rules (passport validity, visas, entry permission letter, COVID-19 etc.) for the host country. Insurance

It is the responsibility of each participant to ensure that in addition to their normal insurance they have sufficient insurance in place to cover any COVID-19 related costs, including repatriation. The LOC of the event and the EJU accept no liability for any claims relating to cancellation of the event due to COVID-19 or medical costs for any COVID-19 related illness that may affect them during the event.

Before and during the event

- Follow the host country's Government COVID-19 measures (see **ENTERING THE HOST COUNTRY** section).
- Follow the IJF COVID-19 Protocol rules (covid.ijf.org).
- Wash/sanitise your hands regularly.
- Report to the EJU or LOC COVID-19 Manager and submit yourself to contactless temperature measurement and/or COVID-19 testing in case of COVID-19 infection suspicion.
- The LOC Government measures may be stricter than those detailed in the IJF COVID-19 protocol or vice versa, the stricter rules **MUST** be followed.

Mask wearing

Mask wearing is optional*, unless it is mandated by the host country's government with the exceptions of competing/refereeing/coaching/awarding ceremony, on/at the field of play tatami, on the warm-up tatami whilst warming up or on the training tatami whilst training, or while eating in designated dining areas.

*The EJU Medical Commission still recommend the wearing of masks in areas where social distancing is not possible.

Exit tests

Exit tests, if required, may be booked with the LOC in advance via hotel & travel form.

EJU/IJF Member Federations can participate at the OTC. The numbers of athletes participating in the EJU OTC may be limited to 500 participants.

7. EJU Participation Fee

30 € per participating athlete.

8. Age

15 years old and over (Born in 2008 and before).

9. Responsibility of the Federations

The athletes will train under the full responsibility of their National Federations. Each National Federation is responsible for insuring its judoka against 'injury and third part risk (public liability)' during the period of the camp. The European Judo Union and Czech Judo Federation decline all responsibility.

10. Accreditation

At least one team delegate (and not more than 2) must attend the accreditation **on Sunday, March 12th 2023 starting from 15:00 till 19:00 and Monday March 13th, starting from 10:00 till 19:00 at Sport Centre Nymburk.** To confirm the entries of all athletes and officials and accommodation payment.

Very important: Each National Federation must be represented by a team leader or coach responsible for registration of ALL athletes from the respective National Federation, regardless club or other membership. Every National Federation will be accepted for accreditation only once, when all entries and payments can be confirmed at the same time.

11. Facilities

Tatami will be approx. 1000 m²; 2 gyms; 2 saunas; 3 running tracks, 1 swimming pool. Other facilities: hot pool with air massage, jacuzzi, Massage rooms.

12. Transport

Airports: Prague International Airport - 20€ one way per person

Railway station: Nymburk

13. Accommodation

Hotels in 3 different categories are offered. A minimum stay of 4 nights is obligatory. Prices are per person and per night including bed & breakfast in single or double/triple rooms. Meals can only be added for the whole period (e.g. only lunch and/or dinner for all days).

Check-out not later than 11:00 am, otherwise an additional night will be charged. Full board starts with dinner on the day of arrival, and ends with lunch on the day of your departure.

In case of any damage to hotel property or training venue caused by members of a delegation, their National Federation will be charged by the organizing committee.

Judoka and Officials who are not staying at the official accommodations have to pay 200€/person in addition to EJU Participation fee.

14. Cancellation policy

Replacements (same hotel booking, different name) are free of charge.

30 days (or more) before accreditation day:

no cancellation costs

29-15 days before accreditation day:

50% refund

Cancellations within 14 days (or less) before accreditation day:

no refund

15. Payment

To confirm your entry, kindly complete the payment for accommodation before 13th of February 2023 to our bank account. All bank fees and money transfer costs must be paid by the sender federation.

In general, no cash payments are allowed (in exceptional cases it can be agreed on bilateral basis between LOC and NF. Credit cards cannot be accepted on spot.
