<b>Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2011</b>	<b>07:00 – 07:30</b> – unofficial weigh-in - Novotel Hotel. <b>07:30 – 08:00</b> – official weigh-in - Novotel Hotel. <b>10:00</b> - eliminator fights and repechage for -60kg, -66kg,-73kg weight categories <b>15:40</b> - Opening ceremony <b>16:00</b> - Bronze medal contests, finals, victory ceremony. The doping control immediately after the ceremony.
<b>Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2011</b>	<b>07:00 – 07:30</b> – unofficial weigh-in - Novotel Hotel. <b>07:30 – 08:00</b> – official weigh-in - Novotel Hotel. <b>10:00</b> - eliminator fights and repechage for -81kg, -90kg,-100kg, +100kg weight categories <b>After</b> - Bronze medal contests, finals, victory ceremony. The doping control immediately after the ceremony.
<b>Monday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2011</b>	Departure of participants.
<b>Transfer</b> Closest Airport and Train Station Transport	Airport Warsaw “Chopin” or railway station Warsaw Central – hotels – competition hall and back are free of charge. Participating National Federations are responsible for their own travel to the Warsaw, Poland.
<b>Participation</b>	This World Cup is open for all EJU / IJF Member Federations: Maximum 4 competitors per weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them.
<b>Competition mode</b>	Competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF – EJU KO system with quarterfinal (last 8) repechage; <b>preliminaries</b> – 4 mats (8 m x 8 m), <b>bronze medals fights</b> – 2 mats (8 m x 8 m), <b>finals</b> – 1 mat (8 m x 8 m),
<b>Duration of contests</b>	5 minutes and the Golden Score 3 minutes.
<b>Weigh-in</b>	Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport (in case of domestic athletes national identity card with photography) at the official weigh-in. For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program

<b>Refereeing</b>	<p>Each federation may enter <b>1 referee</b>  The organizing federation a maximum of <b>4 referees</b>.  Referees must be holding the IJF license A or B.  A referee meeting will be held on <b>Friday 26th February 2011 at 19:00hrs</b> at the Hotel Novotell. The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory.  The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.</p>
<b>Draw</b>	<p>Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest s of the draw – separation by nations.  The draw will take place on Friday at <b>20:00hrs</b> in Hotel Novotel  Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials.  Dress code: jacket suit with tie.</p>
<b>Jumas</b>	<p>All entries must be registered in JUMAS (EJU online registration system).  <a href="http://www.europejudo.com/jumas/">http://www.europejudo.com/jumas/</a>  Deadline for registration is Monday 14th February 2011.  Delegates not registered in Jumas will be charged 30 € late entry fee.  Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per membership instead of € 25 for a member card and € 20 for a competitor card.</p>
<b>Entry Fee</b>	<p>An entry fee of 10 € per athlete must be paid to the EJU during accreditation.</p>
<b>Coaching</b>	<p>All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.  Dress Code:  - Draw: jacket suit and tie  - Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes.  - For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.</p>
<b>Judogi</b>	<p>The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi. Judogi control according to IJF Sokuteiki Rule.  Only Judogi from IJF Suppliers are allowed at the World Cup.  The space on the shoulder stripes can be only used by the EJU Partners who have bought the right to advertise on the Judogi shoulder stripes (25cm x 5cm). EJU Partners can also be the athletes' sponsors, if these would like to show the company in EJU events.  Advertising on the arms (10cm x 10cm on both right and left side) can be used by federations and their Judoka as usual for their own profit.</p>
<b>Back Numbers</b>	<p>All competitors must have the official EJU / IJF Back Number (ordered from <a href="http://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>). The sponsor part will be provided by the organisers during accreditation.  Competitors who still have the 2010 version of the Back Number will be allowed to compete in the EJU World Cups through 2011. From 1st January 2012, only the new version of the Back Number will be allowed.  <b>If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.</b></p>
