Online Booking Tool	<p>The 2011 GB World Cup will be administered via an online booking tool provided by Corporate & Sporting Events (CSE) for all accommodation, transport requirements and to gather all International Federation's information.</p> <p>All Federations will be contacted shortly and asked to complete a numerical entry form. Once completed the federation will be issued a link to setup and authorise their personal account which will then be password protected. The account can be accessed 24 hours a day for Federations to make additions or amends.</p> <p>The online booking tool will allow the individual Federations to amend their accommodation, transport and delegation information easily. All information provided by the Federations will be confirmed via email and will be confidential.</p> <p>All Federations must complete the online booking tool.</p> <p>After completing the online registration, Federations will make all payments to CSE upon receipt of their emailed invoice. All payments must be received within 7 days of the invoice being produced in order to secure accommodation at the official hotel.</p> <p>The online booking tool does not replace JUMAS. All Federations will be required to complete both systems.</p> <p>If for any reason a Federation does not receive the original account authorisation email, they can contact the BJA Events Team (events@britishjudo.org.uk) for assistance.</p>

Referees	Each participating country must be accompanied by 1 Referee having at least continental licence with a valid A or B classification. Organising country may enter a maximum of 4 Referees. The referees meeting will take place at the Jurys Inn Hotel at 19.00hrs on Friday 30th September .	
Accreditation & Registration	<p>Collect accreditation at registration on Friday 30th September at the Jurys Inn Hotel between 10.00 – 18.00. All accreditation must be collected by 18.00. Under no circumstances will any accreditation passes be available to collect after 18.00 on Friday.</p> <p>From 1 – 4 competitors max 4 officials From 5 – 9 competitors max 6 officials From 10 + competitors max 7 officials</p> <p>Extra accreditation for delegation members: £100 for two days. Participants accommodated at a non-official hotel will also have to pay £100 accreditation fee to the organisers.</p>	

Coach dress code	<p>For the Draw: Suit jacket with tie. Elimination rounds: National track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes. For the final block program (TV time): Suit jacket with tie. The following are forbidden at any time: Shorter trousers, sleeveless tops, undressed upper body, any kind of head caps and cover, jeans, sweaters or similar sports unrelated dress, flip-flops.</p>						
Entry Information	<p>1. First Entry (Numerical) National Federations are requested to inform the British Judo Association whether or not they will participate by completing the numerical entry form no later than Friday 19th August 2011. The form will be emailed via CSE to all National Federations.</p> <p>2. Final Entry National Federations are required to complete the British Judo Association online inscription form by Friday 16th September 2011 so all final team requirements can be confirmed with the official hotel. This must be completed via the CSE online booking tool.</p> <p>All EJU / IJF member federations must pay to the EJU a fee of €10 per participant directly at the point of accreditation/registration.</p> <p>The registration for EJU members will be done by JUMAS ELECTRONIC SYSTEM by 15:00 GMT on Monday 26th September 2011. NO LATE INSCRIPTIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Please note: All federations will need to complete both the JUMAS and British Judo's online booking system.</p> <p>Competitors not accommodated in the official hotel must pay £100 per person to the BJA.</p>

Judogis	<p>Blue and white Judogi's will be required. The size of Judogi and publicity on Judogi must be in accordance with the IJF & EJU rules.</p> <p>Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. As from the World Championships 2011 in Paris, all Judogi (Jacket, Trousers and Belt) must have the IJF Official Label with an IJF optical code. Further information can be found in the IJF Judogi Rules.</p>						

<p>Back Numbers</p>	<p>All competitors must have the official EJU / IJF Back Number (ordered from www.mybacknumber.com). The sponsor part will be provided by the organisers during accreditation. Competitors who still have the 2010 version of the Back Number will be allowed to compete in the EJU World Cups through 2011. Financial Terms and Conditions	<p>All payments must be received by Friday 2nd September. Late payment will incur a surcharge of 10% upon the total payable amount.</p> <p>Cancellation charges: Hotel: Before 2nd September 100% refund. Once confirmed the VISA request will then be processed and the National Federation will be contacted via their email address.</p>
