Referees	All teams of three competitors or more must be accompanied by up to two IJF referees A or B (max 2 referees), which is the condition to participate in this tournament to meet the EJU requirements. The Organizing country can enter up to 6 referees. The referees meeting will take place at the Hotel "Sheraton Metekhi Palace" at 19.00 on Friday 23 rd January.			
Competition Rules	Europe 4 athletes maximum per weight category Asia, Africa, Oceania, America 4 athlete maximum per weight category Organizing country 4 athletes maximum per weight category The tournament will be carried out according to the rules and regulations of the IJF/EJU, with quarterfinal repechage system on 2			

	mats. Finals will be on 1 mat. The top 8 among the entered competitors according to the World Ranking List will be seeded.			
Judogis	Blue and white Judogis will be required. The size of Judogi and publicity on Judogi must be in accordance with IJF/EJU rules.			
Draw	The draw will be carried out at 20:00 at the Hotel "Sheraton Metekhi Palace" on Friday 23 rd January.			
Accreditation & Registration	Collect accreditation at registration at the Hotel "Sheraton Metekhi Palace" on Friday 23 th January 13.00 - 18.00. All accreditation must be collected by 18.00. No accreditation passes will be available to collect after 18.00 on Friday. Participants accommodated at a non official hotel will have to pay 100 EURO accreditation fee to the organizers.
