Dear Sport friends,

Borås Judo club has since 2003 been the organizer of Swedish Judo Open by the Swedish Judo federation. Last year, our tournament reached a record of 378 competitors from 27 nations. To develop the event further more in 2011, we have decided to expand the contest from 2 till 3 days. We will also have accreditation and draws on both Thursday and Friday. The main reason behind this decision is to create shorter competition days, which will make it more convenient for the athletes, audience, media and others involved around the event. This also gives us the opportunity to welcome all entries not needing to limit the number of participants.

Another improvement for this year's event is that the EJU training camp from the 31st of October to the 2nd of November will be held at the competition venue with more space and better conditions. We hope and believe that with these changes and improvements the Swedish Judo Open in 2011 will be better than ever.

Borås are situated close to Landvetter Airport and not so far from the Gothenburg City Airport. We will take care of all transportation from these airports and the official hotel during the competition and camp.

Cash payments at the venue will be charged 10 EUR extra per participant as an administration fee. All expenses prepaid by bank transfer will be refunded if the competitor cannot participate.		
Award Money:	There is 1 000 € award money for the Winner of each category. The minimum number of participants per weight category should be 8 competitors. If there is less, the award is 500 €. Minimum 4 competitors.		
EJU Training Camp:	From Monday 31/10 to Wednesday 2/11 will there be an EJU training camp. All prices include accommodation at Hotel Plaza and full board and camp fee from Monday 31/11 until Thursday morning 3/11. Single room 435 € per person for the whole camp Double room 350 € per person for the whole camp Triple room 290 € per person for the whole camp Four bed room 240 € per person for the whole camp Camp only 50 €		
EJU Camp Fee:	Through EJU regulation the organizer has to take out an extra camp fee for every participant with 100 €. For EJU athletes 30 €.

SENIOR EUROPEAN CUP SWEDISH JUDO OPEN 28 October-30 October 2011

- Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2010 EJU / IJF back number will only be accepted in European Cups until 31st December 2011.
- 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.
- 3. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
