Doping control:

The Gold Medal Winner and another drawn Medalist from the rest per weight category are obliged to take a doping test.

Referees:

Each participating National Federation must be accompanied by one referee having IJF continental "A" or "B" licence but not more than 2 referees. This is a necessary condition of participating in tournaments, to meet the EJU requirements.

Special rules:

According to the IJF new tournament system the number of competitors is limited as below:

Per countries 4 competitors max. per weight categories from organizing country 4 competitor max. per weight categories. KO system with quarterfinal (last 8) repechage. Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to WRL, rest of draw – separation by nations.

Liability:

Neither the organizers of the event nor the Hungarian Judo Association (nor any its officials or members) will be liabe or responsible for arising accident or damage during of participation or traveling in connection with this championship.

Advertisements:

Regulation of EJU concerning advertisements on judogi is to be obliged. <u>During the tournaments back numbers on the judogi provided by the organizer are allowed only. Back numbers of previous tournaments must be removed from the judogi.</u>
