Participants	In the Seminar, there will be analyzed the following Kata: Nage-no-Kata, Katame-no-Kata, Adapted Nage no Kata and clarifications regarding the kind of mistake in the different kata. The course will be based on theory, analysis of video and practice. The Seminar will take place on the tatami and participants must wear judogi. It is requested to each National Federation having Continental Kata Judges to enter up at least one qualified Judge. The Seminar will be session for examination of new Continental Kata Judges in Nage-no-Kata, Katame-no-Kata, Ju-no-Kata, Kime-no-Kata, Kodokan Goshin jutsu or to extend the number of Kata licenses to the Judges that have not licensed for these Katas. <u>Criteria for the Candidates</u> <u>AGE AND GRADE :</u> <u>1st level</u> - Age: from 25 years (only for Nage no Kata and Katame no Kata) - Minimum dan grade required : 3thdan <u>2st level</u> - Age :from 30 years (for all 5 Kata: Nage no Kata- Katame no Kata - Ju no Kata – Kime no Kata – Kodokan Goshin Jutsu) - Minimum dan grade required : 4thdan <u>General Requirements :</u> - National license - Active judge on national and regional levels - English knowledge at the level of communication The Candidates that passed the theoretical and examination will be observed and evaluated as Judges in the EJU Kata Tournament. The EJU Kata Commission has created and activated an e-learning platform dedicated to candidates for Kata Judges (documents, video, test, etc.).
