The theoretical and practical part will take place on the tatami on Friday, 27 March and participants must wear white judogi.</p> <p>TOPICS :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- General Kata Competition Criteria for the Evaluations 2025- Analysis of the various situations of MEDIUM MISTAKE in different kata- Clarifications regarding specific situations during competitions. <p>It is requested to each National Federation having Continental Kata Judges to enter up at least one qualified Judge.</p> <p>The Seminar will be session for examination of new Continental Kata Judges in Nage-no-Kata, Katame-no-Kata, Ju-no-Kata, Kime-no-Kata, Kodokan-Goshin-Jutsu, Koshiki-no-Kata, Itsutsu-no-Kata or to extend the number of Kata licenses to the Judges that have not licensed for these Katas.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Criteria for the Candidates</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>AGE AND GRADE:</u> <p><u>1st level</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Age: from 25 years (only for Nage no Kata and Katame no Kata)• Minimum dan grade required: 3thdan <p><u>2st level</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Age: from 30 years (for all 7 Kata: Nage-no-Kata, Katame-no-Kata, Ju-no-Kata, Kime-no-Kata, Kodokan-Goshin-Jutsu, Koshiki-no-Kata, Itsutsu-no-Kata)• Minimum dan grade required: 4thdan <p><u>General Requirements :</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. National license2. Active judge on national and regional levels3.
