### **3. Important Information**

#### **Before Travelling**

Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of arrival.

- Check host country entry requirements and airline requirements (if applicable).
- Check if you need a visa, and if yes, request it from the LOC according to the details in the **ENTERING THE HOST COUNTRY** section.
- Send travel information (arrival and departures) to the LOC.
- Book accommodation with the LOC.

### **Entering host country**

Each individual is responsible to ensure they follow the entry rules (passport validity, visas, entry permission letter, etc.) for the host country. The LOC will assist with visas where possible but having the correct visa is the responsibility of each participant. Visa applications will only be accepted for people who are inscribed in judobase for the event. It is the responsibility of the National Federation to ensure that their delegation respects the conditions of stay defined by the Government of the country hosting the event. If any participant does not respect these conditions, any costs arising will be borne by the National Federation concerned. Please note that visa approvals or rejections are done by the Government authorities and the LOC has no control over this and cannot be held responsible for any rejections

## **7. EJU Participation Fee**

60 € per participating athlete.

## **8. Age**

15 years old and over (Born in 2011 and before).

## **9. Responsibility of the Federations**

The athletes will train under the full responsibility of their National Federations. Each National Federation is responsible for insuring its judoka against 'injury and third part risk (public liability)' during the period of the camp. The European Judo Union and Spanish Judo Federation decline all responsibility.

## **10. Accreditation**

At least one team delegate (and not more than 2) must attend the accreditation on

- **Sunday, July 05<sup>th</sup>** from 14:00 till 20:00
- and **Monday, July 06<sup>th</sup> 2026** from 10:00 till 19:00

**Palazzetto dello Sport** to confirm the entries of all athletes and officials and accommodation payment.

Very important: Each National Federation must be represented by a team leader or coach responsible for registration of ALL athletes from the respective National Federation, regardless club or other membership. Every National Federation will be accepted for accreditation only once, when all entries and payments can be confirmed at the same time.

## **11. Facilities**

Tatami will be approx. 800 m2. Other facilities include: indoor pool, sauna, spa, gym.

## 12. Transport

Airport: International Airport Torino-Caselle "Sandro Pertini" (TRN)

Train Station: Bardonecchia Train Station

Bus station: n/a

The organizer will provide transfers between the airport, train station and official hotels and all other facilities related to the event to those participants who have booked official hotel through the organizer (not on his own). Transfer cost from Torino airport is 30 € per person one way. Transfers for this price can be offered only for groups max. 4 people.

For transfers from other airports - please, consult the organizer.

## 13. Accommodation

Hotels in 2 different categories are offered. A minimum stay of 4 nights is obligatory. Prices are per person and per night full board in single, double, triple or quad rooms.

Reservations will be processed according to the date of your booking. In case your chosen category is fully booked, you will be informed and requested to make a new reservation.

In case of higher requests, Athletes will be accommodated in other facilities in the surrounding area, within 10 km.

Check-out time is as mentioned above, otherwise an additional night will be charged.

Organiser will assign hotels to the participants according to the category booked.

In case of any damage to hotel property or training venue caused by members of a delegation, their National Federation will be charged by the organizing committee.

Judoka and Officials who are not staying at the official accommodations have to pay 200€/person in addition to EJU Participation fee.

## 14. Cancellation policy

Hotel reservation deadline is 05<sup>th</sup> June, 2026. The reservation sent by then is binding. **For reservations sent after the hotel deadline, the organizer can charge an extra surcharge of 10%.** However, in this case the organizer is not obliged to provide accommodation and can just charge the service fee.

Replacements (same hotel booking, different name) are free of charge.

30 days (or more) before accreditation day:

no cancellation costs

29-15 days before accreditation day:

50% refund

Cancellations within 14 days (or less) before accreditation day: no refund  
In case of training camp cancellation by the local authorities full payment will be refunded.  
**Important: Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation of rooms.**

## 15. Payment

To confirm your entry, kindly complete the payment for accommodation before 05<sup>th</sup> of June 2026 to our bank account. All bank fees and money transfer costs must be paid by the sender federation.  
In general, **no cash payments are allowed** (in exceptional cases it can be agreed on bilateral basis between LOC and NF). Credit cards can not be accepted on spot.

## 17. Media

The training sessions of OTCs are generally closed to the media to ensure the privacy and concentration of participating teams. Access to the training sessions may be granted exclusively upon request and is strictly limited to sessions designated as "Open for Media" in the event outlines, provided that all applications are processed through EJU Media accreditation system (<https://www.eju.net/media/>). Permitted media personnel must wear their accreditation card visibly at all times and strictly follow the established media rules for OTCs.

It is important to note that registering media personnel as team officials or holding multiple functions is strictly prohibited, as individuals may only be inscribed with one function per event. Furthermore, team officials and other members of the delegation are not permitted to use professional photography or video equipment, including tripods, laptops, mobile phones or selfie sticks during the official training sessions.
