Judogi and backnumbers	• The white and blue judogi are obligatory.	
	• All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website.	
	 Judogi control according to the Sokuteiki Rule. 	
	• All competitors are obliged to have back number on their judogi:	
	1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back	
	of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number.	
	2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing	
	of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be	
	ordered from <u>www.mybacknumber.com</u> . Production and delivery takes around	
	4 weeks. Sewing can be provided by organizers on the spot for 25 euro per each	
	number.	
	3. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the	

	competition, No reserve judogi will be available. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on	
	the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes

Accommodation should be only booked through Russian Judo Federation. The deadline for bookings - <u>06 March 2012.</u> National Federations are responsible for their own expenses to/from Moscow. Organizers will provide domestic transportation from/to Moscow airport/railway station to/from Tver and between official hotel and sporthall. Tver is around 175 km from Moscow. We highly recommend to arrive to Moscow airport – Sheremetievo.

VISA	In case you require visa to enter Russia, we kindly ask you to complete visa application form and send it to the Russian Judo Federation by fax +7 (495) 637 02 57 or by email <u>rjf@judo.ru</u> and <u>rusjudo@gmail.com</u> not later than <u>06 March 2012.</u> Please be informed that it usually takes 5-7 working days to get approval from our Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Only after the receiving of this approval we can send you the invitation with confirmation. To obtain this approval <u>first page of the passport with photo and personal data is obligatory</u> . Schengen States – no passport copies needed, just filled in visa form.
