Participation	This World Cup is open for all EJU / IJF Member Federations: Maximum 4 competitors per weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them.					



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Accreditation. Control of entries	At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on Friday 1st of June 2012 from 10:00 to 18:00 in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or photocopy of passport).			
Age	Minimum 15 years of age (born in 1997 or before)			
Competition Mode	The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU. Competition system: An elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.			
Duration of contests	5 minutes and the Golden Score 3 minutes.			
Weigh-in	Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport at the official weigh-in. For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program			
Refereeing	Each federation may enter 1 referee The organizing federation a maximum of 4 referees . Referees must be holding the IJF license A or B and with a valid classification A or B.			
	A referee meeting will be held on Friday 1st of June 2012 at 19:00hrs at the HOTEL CENTRO NORTE.			
	The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.			
Draw	Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest s of the draw – separation by nations.			
	The draw will take place on Friday at 20:00hrs in the HOTEL CENTRO NORTE. Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials.			
	<u>Dress code:</u> jacket suit with tie			
Jumas	According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday 28 th May 2012 (of the week of the Tournament). Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty			
	per participant. Jumas membership must then be ordered through the federation. Jumas website: https://jumas12.net/user/login			
Entry Fee	An entry fee of 10 € per athlete must be paid to the EJU during accreditation.			
Coaching	All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Forbidden is coaching throughout the contest, the coach is only allowed to speak to his athlete between Matte and Hajime Dress Code: - Draw: jacket suit and tie - Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or			
For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie. The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi. Judogi control IJF Sokuteiki Rule. Only Judogi from IJF suppliers will be allowed.				
	Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. Detailed information is available from http://www.eju.net/statutes			



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All competitors must have the official EJU / IJF Back Number (ordered from www.mybacknumber.com). The sponsor part will be provided by the organisers during accreditation. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, no reserve Judogis will be available

If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.
