	Special Refereeing Rules for Cadets:					
	<ul> <li>- Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition.</li> </ul>					
	- Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.					
Back Numbers	Numerical Inscriptions must be sent in about 2 months before. The participating federation should how many athletes will be participating.					
	Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 201 EJU / IJF back number. The 2011 Back Number version is obligatory.					
	The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <u>www.mybacknumber.com</u> . Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition. No reserve Judo Gi will be available.					
	The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
