	EJU / IJF Dress Code: jacket suit with tie.		
Weigh-in	Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport or identity card with photo at the official weigh-in.		
	Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. <b>Additional 100g</b> will be allowed for their weight category limits. For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program.		
Defenseine	The Refereeing will be according to the EJU/IJF refereeing rules.		
Refereeing	Special Refereeing Rules for Cadets:		
	Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition. Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime		
	waza is not allowed to continue the competition		
Referee	Each delegation should bring an IJF/ Continental licensed referee.		
	A referee meeting will be held on Saturday 19 <sup>th</sup> May 2012 at 9:00h at the Sport Hall		
Jumas	All entries must be registered in JUMAS (EJU online registration system). https://jumas12.net/user/login		
	Deadline for registration is <b>Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2012.</b>		
	Delegates not registered in Jumas will be charged 30 € late entry fee.		
	Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per membership.		
Coaching	The coach is responsible for his athlete's conduct from entering the competition venue until		
	leaving it, before and after each contest.		
	Coaching will be strictly limited to communication with athlete, tactical advice,		
	encouragement, instructions in unexpected situations, as injury, etc.		
	The coach will remain seated on his chair throughout the contest and will leave the mat together with his athlete.		
	The coach should make sure that the competitor leaves the mat immediately; otherwise the whole team will be suspended.

Judogi	Blue & White Judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule.
	All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website.
Back Numbers	Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2011 Back Number version is obligatory.
	The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <u>www.mybacknumber.com</u> . Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available.
	The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
