Participation	Eligibility: Only members of EJU/IJF affiliated National Judo Federations may enter.		
	<b>Age Limits:</b> Players must be born in 1997 (15 years and over - in the calendar year) or before AND must be a SENIOR licence holder.		
	Minimum grades: Men: 1st Dan, Women: 1st Kyu.		
	<b>EJU Ranking Points:</b> In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category must have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision.		
Accreditation, Registration & Draw	Registration for all categories will take place on <b>Friday 11th May 2012</b> from 10:00hrs – 18:00hrs in the Goodwood Suite at the Gatwick Hilton Hotel (South Terminal, Gatwick Airport, West Sussex, RH6 0LL).

Back Numbers	All competitors must have the official 2011 EJU / IJF Back Number (ordered from www.mybacknumber.com). The 2011 Back Number is obligatory.
	The participating athlete / Federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around four weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be withdrawn from the competition, No Reserve Judo Gi will be available.
	The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
	If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.

#### Hotel Package

The following accommodation is available at specially negotiated rates and available only when booked direct through the CSE online booking tool by the closing date **strictly Monday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2012.**

- A four star hotel just three minutes walk from Gatwick's South Terminal.

#### Payments:

All accommodation payments are to be made via the CSE office. Once the booking is received via the online booking tool CSE will email an invoice which is to be paid immediately. NO ACCOMMODATION PAYMENTS are to be made directly to the British Judo Association, EJU or the Hotel.

All payments must be made to CSE, as above by Monday 30th April 2012.

All rooms will be allocated on a first come first serve basis and will only be guaranteed, processed and confirmed once payment is received. Hotel rooms are non-cancellable and non-refundable under any circumstances.

#### Rooms are limited so early booking is highly recommended

Competitors not accommodated in the official hotel must pay £100 per person to the BJA.

On arrival, guests staying at the Hilton Hotel for this event must checkin in the Goodwood Suite, not the hotel's front desk.

#### Travel

It is strongly recommended to fly into **London Gatwick Airport**, as the official hotel and event registration is at the Hilton Hotel, Gatwick Airport (South Terminal).







## SENIOR EUROPEAN CUP 2012 LONDON BRITISH OPEN A TOP RANKING EVENT K2, CRAWLEY 12<sup>TH</sup> & 13<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2012

A monorail is available from Gatwick Airport North Terminal to Gatwick Airport South Terminal. Therefore, no transport is required from Gatwick Airport as the Hilton Hotel is attached to the South Terminal. If you are arriving at any other airport or require any assistance with your travel arrangements to the Hilton Hotel, CSE will be able to assist you so please contact them via their online booking tool. Please note: Transfers from alternative transport terminals will be price on requested by CSE.

Please note that travelling time to the Hotel at Gatwick Airport from Stansted Airport will be approx 2.5 hours, and travelling time to the Hotel at Gatwick Airport from Heathrow Airport will be approx 1 hour (subject to traffic). Please note, travelling time to K2 Leisure Centre, Crawley from Gatwick Airport is approximately 30 minutes.

For players, coaches and officials accommodated at the official hotel, a free shuttle bus service will operate on competition days from the Hilton hotel (only) to K2 Crawley, West Sussex – further information will be provided at registration.

#### **Venue Directions:**

- Turn off the M23 at Junction 11.
- Take the A23 towards Crawley.
- At the first set of traffic lights turn right in the K2 Leisure centre.
