Closest Airport and Train Station Transport	The organizer will provide transfers between the Tbilisi airport or railway station and official hotel and between the official hotel and competition venue.  Transportation will be offered only to those participants who are accommodated in the official hotel.  Participating National Federations are responsible for their own travel to the GEORGIA, TBILISI.		
Participation	This <i>European Open</i> is open for all EJU / IJF Member Federations: <u>Maximum 4 competitors</u> per weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them.		
Accreditation. Control of entries	At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on Friday  1 <sup>st</sup> February 2013 from 10:00 to 18:00 in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or national ID card with photography or photocopy of passport).		
Age	Minimum 15 years of age (born in <b>1998</b> or before)		
Competition Mode	The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU. The new IJF testing rules approved for a period until the WC Rio de Janeiro 2013 will be applied for the European Open.		
	Competition system: Elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.		
Duration of contests	5 Minutes - Golden Score without time limit.		
	Athletes must present their <i>EJU accreditation</i> and <i>Passport</i> or national ID card with photography at the official weigh-in.		
Weigh-in	For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program.		
	The scales for check of the weight will be provided from <b>08:00 until 19:00</b> in Hotel Holiday Inn on days of the official weigh-in.		
Refereeing	Each federation may enter <b>1 referee</b> The organizing federation a maximum of 4 <b>referees</b> .  Referees must be holding the IJF license A or B and with a valid classification A or B.		
	A referee meeting will be held on <u>Friday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2013 at 19:00hrs</u> at the <u>Hotel Holiday Inn.</u>		
	The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.		
Draw	Seeding of the <b>Top 8</b> among the entered competitors according to <b>the IJF World Ranking List</b> . The rest of the draw – separation by nations.		
	The draw will take place on Friday 1 <sup>st</sup> February at <b>20:00hrs</b> in Hotel Holiday Inn . Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials.		
	<u>Dress code:</u> jacket suit with tie		





	According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas. The deadline is <b>Monday</b> 28 <sup>th</sup> January 2013 (of the week of the

	Delegates not registered in Jumas will be charged 30 € late entry fee. Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per membership.			
Entry Fee	An entry fee of 10 € per athlete must be paid to the EJU during accreditation.			
Coaching	All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.  Dress Code: - Draw: jacket suit and tie - Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit and tie - For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.			
Judogi	The white and blue judogi are obligatory. Judogi control is performed according to the Sokuteiki Rule. All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. See Official Suppliers on the EJU website. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. Detailed information is available on <a href="http://www.eju.net/statutes">http://www.eju.net/statutes</a> If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.			
Back Numbers	All competitors must have the official EJU / IJF Back Number (ordered from www.mybacknumber.com or www.ijfbacknumber.com). The sponsor part will be provided by the organisers during accreditation. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, no reserve Judogis will be available  If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.
