# 5. Age

15 years old and over (Born in 1998 and before)

## 6. Entry fee

The EJU entry fee of 10€ per athlete must be paid.

# 7. Participation

This European Open is open for all EJU / IJF Member Federations.

Maximum of 4 competitors per weight category for every Federation.

The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them.

# 8. Accreditation & Control of Entries

At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on Friday 31 May 2013 from 10:00 to 18:00 in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time, a nation will not be put into draw and will not be allowed to start. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or photocopy of passport).

### 9. Jumas registration & Deadlines

All entries must be registered in JUMAS (EJU online registration system)

Deadline for registration is Monday 27 May 2013.

For participants without JUMAS entry for the event but holding a valid JUMAS licence (membership) a penalty fee of  $\in$  30 per participant is charged. For participants without valid JUMAS licence (membership) a penalty fee of  $\in$  60 per participant is charged.

JUMAS licence must be ordered through the federation in advance of the event. Ordering on the spot during accreditation is not possible (for further details see the JUMAS-Guide on EJU website: http://www.eju.net/statutes).

# **10.** Categories & Duration

Male: -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, -100, +100 kg Duration: 5 minutes . Golden Score: No time limit

# 11. Weigh-in

Official scales will be available for test weigh-in from 08:00 – 22:00, except for 19:00-19:30

Official weigh-in for each weight category shall be held the evening before the competition day. For Statistical proposes, a weigh-in in judogi will be operated in the morning of competition during judogi control, prior to the first fight. Athletes must present their EJU accreditation card and his/her passport (National ID Card showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

#### **12.** Competition Mode

Competition system: Elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU. The new testing rules approved for a period until the WC Rio de Janeiro 2013 will be applied for the European Open.

### 13. Draw

Seeding of the Top 8 among the entered competitors according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest of the draw – separation by nations.

The draw will take place on Friday at 20:00hrs in Hotel RIN Grand .

Each delegation must be represented at the draw (maximum two officials).

Dress code: Jacket suit with tie.

### 14. Refereeing

Each federation may enter 1 referee with at least continental licence and valid classification A or B. The organizing federation may enter a maximum of 4 referees.

Referees must be holding the IJF license A or B and with a valid classification A or B.

The referee meeting will be held on Friday 31 May 2013 at 19:00hrs at Hotel RIN Grand. The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.

## 15. Coaching

All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.

## 16. Judogi

#### **Approved Judogi**

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi (white and blue judogi are obligatory) - see official suppliers on the EJU website.

#### Judogi Control

Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule.


#### Markings

Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. The space on the shoulder stripes can be only used by the EJU Suppliers. Advertising on the arms (10cm x 10cm on both right and left side) can be used by federations and their Judoka as usual for their own benefit. #### Backnumber

Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have sewn on the back of his judogi the official backnumber (both EJU and IJF are allowed) bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The backnumber can be ordered from <u>www.ijfbacknumber.com</u> or <u>www.mybacknumber.com</u> (Attention: production and delivery takes around 4 weeks).



The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.

If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Backnumber, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.

## 17. Transport

Airport: Henri Coanda International Airport

The organizer will provide transfers between the Henri Coanda International airport and official hotel and between the official hotel and competition venue. Transportation will be offered only to those participants who are accommodated in the official hotel. Participating National Federations are responsible for their own travel to Henri Coanda International Airport/ROU.

All participants to be accredited should stay at the official hotel. In case of any damage to hotel property or competition venue caused by members of a delegation, their national federation will be charged by the organizing committee.

Reservations at the official hotels have to be booked exclusively through the organizer on a first come – first serve base.

Delegates accommodated in nonofficial hotel will pay Accreditation fee 100 EURO per athlete and delegate.
