The Ecco Judo Team Challenge Europe vs. Asia 2014 is an interesting initiative, involving two successful judo continents – Europe and Asia.

Considering the latest medal haul during the London Olympic Games and the Rio World Championships, the outstanding results and achievements of these two continents are incontestable.

With this challenge, a new type of competition and a new motivation is offered to the athletes and the judo public. I would like to thank the European judo Union for their initiative and also the Government of the Tyumen region, for hosting one more time an important judo event.

The IJF is glad to entrust the Government of Tyumen and the Russian Judo Federation with the organization and we do hope that the competition will be a resounding success, marking the beginning of what will become a tradition in the world of judo.

ECCO JUDO TEAM CHALLENGE 2014 - Europe vs. Asia

1. TEAMS

Each team will consist of 14 competitors, 7 (seven) women and 7 (seven) men in the following weight categories:

Women: -48 kg; -52 kg; -57 kg; -63 kg; -70 kg; -78 kg; +78 kg Men: -60 kg; -66 kg; -73 kg; -81 kg; -90 kg; -100 kg; +100 kg

2. NOMINATION OF TEAMS

The EJU and the JUA will decide their own criteria of selection of competitors for their continental teams. Competitors must be of a nationality (country) belonging to the respective Continental Judo Union. The age of competitors and other conditions are as defined in the IJF SOR.

The EJU and JUA will appoint the following team officials for their team:

- One Team Manager responsible for coordination of the team before and during the event.
- Maximum five (5) coaches.

3. PRESENTATION OF TEAMS

Will be held on Friday, 24 January 2014 at 14:00 in the Tyumen Technopark Congress Hall. All athletes and coaches are obliged to attend the presentation for media, following press conference and photo sessions authorised by the OC.

Dress code: For athletes the Continental Union track suit uniform.

The delegations are responsible for providing their athletes with appropriate uniforms supplied exclusively by one of the official IJF suppliers according to Article 8 of these Rules. For coaches jacket suit and tie.

4. WEIGH-IN

The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF SOR, Article 16.

The Weigh-in will be conducted on 24 January 2014, the day before the team competition.

A weight tolerance of 2 kg will be given.

The weigh-in will be held in the Hotel Vostok.

5. COMPETITION SYSTEM

The competition will consist of one round of 14 individual contests.

The contests will be fought alternatively women and men in order of weight categories from the lightest to heaviest:

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W -48kg, M -60kg, W -52kg, M -66kg, W -57kg, M -73kg, W -63kg M -81kg, W -70kg, M -90kg, W -78kg, M -100kg, W +78kg, M +100kg
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6. COMPOSITION OF THE TEAMS

All competitors presented for the team contest at the official bow on the mat have to compete. If a competitor does not compete, his team will not receive the share of prize money allocated for individual wins.

7. DURATION OF CONTESTS

Each contest will be of five (5) minutes for Men and of four (4) minutes for Women (real time) and Golden Score without any time limit.

8. JUDOGI CONTROL

Approved judogi

Competitors should wear an IJF approved judogi supplied by one of the following manufacturers: Green Hill, SFJAM NORIS, DANRHO, MIZUNO, Double D Adidas, HAYAKAWA, Fighting Films, Budo Sport AG, ESSIMO, MATSURU B.V.

Judogi Control

It will be operated with a sokuteiki prior the contest. Judogi must have an IJF Official Label "APPROVED JUDOGI" with an optical code which cannot be falsified. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

Backnumbers

Each competitor is obliged to bring his judogi clean of backnumber or any back sponsors stickers. The event backnumbers with name and continent abreviation will be sewn to judogis upon arrival of athletes to Tyumen.

9. REFEREEING RULES

Refereeing will be conducted by IJF International referees in accordance with the Refereeing Rules of the IJF approved after the Rio de Janeiro World Championships 2013 and valid from January 2014. There will be 4 referees and 1 Referee Director appointed by the IJF.

10. DECISION

If at the end of the contest there is not at least a difference of a Yuko or a Shido between the two competitors the contest will continue according to Golden Score rule.

The number of contests won will decide the winning team.

In case the number of individual wins of boths teams is equal (7 - 7) the team with higher sum of winning technical scores is winner. In the case the sum of winning technical scores is also equal, there will be draw of one category men for decisive contest under Golden Score rule.

11. MEDICAL SERVICES

The Organizer will provide one medical doctor for each team to be available from teams arrivals until the end of competition. The doctor will have at their disposal all the neccessary medical materials for the athletes for both training and during the competion, such as tape, desinfection, etc. Other medical services will be provided according to the IJF regulations.

13. AWARDS

The organizer shall provide for presentation:

The winning team: 1 trophy, 15 gold medals
The second place: 1 trophy, 15 silver medals

14. PRIZE MONEY

Prize fund: 128.000 USD (one hundred and twenty eight thousand US Dollars) The winning team shall receive 100.000 USD (7.000 USD per athlete and 2.000 USD for the Team Manager). In addition to this, every athlete who won her/his fight (regardless for which team), will receive 2.000 USD.

15. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

The Organizer shall cover for each team, 14 athletes, Team Manager and 5 coaches as per Articles 1. and 2.1 (20 persons in total):

- Flight tickets from Europe to Tyumen and back
- Flight tickets from Asia to Tyumen and back
- Accommodation for 3 nights with full board in official hotel, according to Program
- Gala dinner
- Transfers from Tyumen airport to hotel, all transfers related to training and competition.
- Additional delegation members can be nominated by EJU and JUA at their expenses.
