Teams will be met at Gdańsk International Airport, Gdynia Glowna Railway station (but not in Gdansk), Gdynia or Gdansk for coming by ferries.	
Entries:	ATTENTION: Entries only possible by the National Judo Federations –IJF Members. First entry before 26 th June 2009 Form delivered to the Polish Judo Association. Hotel reservation 10 th July 2009 Form delivered to the Polish Judo Association. Final entry and travel plan before 10 th July 2009 Form delivered to the Polish Judo Association. All hotel reservation must be done only via Polish Judo Association and staying expenses paid to the PZ Judo bank account. Please make payment via bank transfer before 10 th July 2009.	
Competition mode:	Competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF – EJU: double repechage competition system; Preliminaries – 4 mats (8 m x 8 m), Bronze medals fights – 2 mats (8 m x 8 m), Finals – 1 mat (8 m x 8 m), Competition time of fights - 4 min, Golden Score-2 min. The white and blue judogi are obligatory.	
Weight categories:	Women: - 44kg, 48kg, 52kg, 57kg, 63kg, 70kg, 78kg, +78 kg. Men: - 55kg, 60kg, 66kg, 73kg, 81kg, 90kg, 100kg, +100 kg.	
Judogi:	All competitors must have and use own judogi white and blue conformity / according with the EJU rules.	
Participants:	Juniors - women & men born 1990 -1994. Presentation of passports or photocopy will be required at the registration and passports at weight-in.	
Referee:	All participating National Federations are kindly requested to bring international referee to secure neutral refereeing.
