Invited countries:	IJF and EJU member countries	
Competition system:	The events will be organized in accordance with the rules and sporting codes of the IJF / EJU, quarter final repechage system, on 3 mats	
Referees:	Maximum per country: Organizing country 6 Referees Other countries 2 Referees Referees must be holding the IJF license, A or B.	
Judogis:	Please note that according to the decision of the DC of the EJU blue and white judogis will be obligatory. All athletes taking part in the EJU World Cups / Super World Cups have to carry their <b>surname</b> on the back of their judogi.	
Entry Fee:	According to the EJU requirements, each competitor at the EJU World Cup Tournament is obliged to pay the <b>EJU fee of EUR 10</b> to the EJU. This amount must be paid by the National Federations for each their competitor.	
Liability:	Every competitor takes part on his own risk. Each National Federation is responsible for its judokas and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their judokas and their officials, including the referees during the event.	
Transportation:	From the airport Minsk or railway station Minsk to the Hotel and from the hotel to the Competition hall – by the organizer for all participants accommodated in the official hotels. Please, send Travel Details Form in due time.	
Special Rules	According to the qualifying system of the Olympic Games and the EJU decision the number of athletes from:  European countries: 4 competitors maximum per weight category  Non European: 4 competitors maximum per weight category  Organizing nation: 4 competitors maximum per weight category	
Visas	You can arrange entry visas to Belarus either in the country of your residence (if there is a Consular Department of Belarus in your country), or at the international airport "MINSK-2" (code MSQ) upon arrival.  Please, send in due time the list of delegation members with their valid passport details (number, dates of issue and expiry), date of birth and intended period of stay (arrival/departure dates) to the tournament organizer. Please, specify where your delegation is planning to obtain visas – in your country, or at the ART.  Important information: The cost of Entry Visa to Belarus at Minsk Airport Consular Department for the countries having not the Consular Department of Belarus: Individual – EURO 80. For the countries who have Belarus Embassy- the cost of Entry Visa is EURO 100.  Group (no less than 5 persons) –40/per person (Payment in USD and Euros).
