The Seminar will be a session for examination of new Continental Kata Judges or to extend the number of Kata licences to the Judges that have not a licence for these Katas. Criteria for the Candidates: Minimum Age = 30 years old Minimum grade = 4 th dan Each Candidate can be examined for maximum two of the three Katas analysed during the seminar. The examination will be based on: 1. Knowledge of the rules, attitude and organization – written 2. Knowledge of the Kata principles – practical on the mat
