### **2. Date & Place**

May 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> 2009, at Miranda do Corvo Sport Hall, Portugal

### **3. Competitors' Age**

Both men and women competitors must be born between January 1<sup>st</sup> 1994 and December 31<sup>st</sup> 1995.

### **4. Weight Categories & Duration**

**Men:** -50Kg, -55Kg, -60Kg, -66Kg, -73Kg, -81Kg, -90Kg, +90kg  
**Women:** -40kg, -44Kg, -48Kg, -52Kg, -57Kg, -63Kg, -70Kg, +70Kg

Duration: 4 minutes      Golden Score: 2 minutes

### **5. Inscriptions**

The NUMERICAL before March 19<sup>th</sup>  
The NOMINAL before April 16<sup>th</sup>  
**All athletes' inscriptions must be done through JUMAS System (EJU).**

If there are not entries from at least 2 countries in any weight category by deadline of JUMAS registration, organizer is obliged to immediately inform the NF concerned.

### **6. Transfers**

The Portuguese Judo Federation assures the transportation of the delegation members inscribed by the official entry list between **Lisbon International Airport** and Coimbra.

### **7. Accreditation**

The Accreditation will take place at the official hotel, according to the attached Official Programme. Please note that transfer between Lisbon Airport and Coimbra will take about 2 hours.

### **8. Draw**

The draw will take place in the Hotel Dona Inês, according to the attached Official Programme.  
No seeding, only separation by nations.

### **9. Competition System:**

2 entries: better of 3 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide. In this case Ranking List points will be awarded only to 1st place  
3,4,5 entries: pool system (round robin). Ranking List points awarded according to final placing, at least 1 win is required.  
6, 7 and more entries: KO system with double repechage.

Judokas representing at least 2 different countries must be competing in a particular weight category in order to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List.

### **10. Weigh-in**

The weigh-in will take place in the morning on each day of the event at the hotels, according to the attached Official Programme.

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
Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a t-shirt.

## 11. Clothing

Blue and White judogi are obligatory. Each national Federation must bring spare judogi.

Please note that the **new back identification** of athletes is compulsory in all IJF/EJU events from the 1st January 2010. Athletes without the new back identification will not be allowed to compete, **no exceptions permitted**.

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.
2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from [www.mybacknumber.com](http://www.mybacknumber.com). Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.
3. The CHANGEABLE part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.





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All Judoka must ensure that the Judogi conforms to these rules and therefore remove the non-EJU Official Supplier advertising or change the jacket. It is not allowed to tape or cover any non-authorized suppliers as this would affect the judogi design and the grip of the opponent. Therefore, Judogi with advertising of non-suppliers on shoulder stripes cannot be used.

**Acceptable markings**

1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100 cm<sup>2</sup>.
2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm<sup>2</sup>. EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm<sup>2</sup>)
4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.
5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.



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## 12. Insurance

The Portuguese Judo Federation will not be responsible for any injury, damage or loss during the competition.

## 13. Refereeing

The Referee Meeting will be at the Sport hall in the morning of the first day of competition (9am), according to the Attached Programme.

### Special Refereeing Rules for Cadets:

Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action If any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If torus applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition.

Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due toshime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.
