7. Participating competitors:	1.National teams entered exclusively through their National Federations. 2.Judokas representing at least 2 different countries must be competing in a weight category in order to obtain points for the EJU Junior RL. 3.Participation per foreign country per weight category is limited to 4 athletes			
8. Competition mode:	Competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF/EJU: double repechage competition system (6 and more entries); 3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin). 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 third match will decide;			
	In order to obtain points to the EJU Ranking List his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organizer's decision. If, after the nominal deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.			
	Preliminaries – 4 mats (8 m x 8 m), Bronze medals fights – 2 mats (8 m x 8 m), Finals – 1 mat (8 m x 8 m)			
Duration of contests:	Time of contest - 4 min, Golden Score-2 min.			
9. Draw: Seeding: Dress code:	Seeding of the top 4 competitors among the entered athletes according to the EJU junior RL. The rest - separation by nations. Note: EJU dress code is obligatory for the draw and final block (suit with tie)			
10. Referee:	All participating National Federations are kindly requested to bring at least one international referee to secure neutral refereeing: A or B or national level.			
11. Referee meeting:	Saturday 23 rd July 2010 9:00 Sport Hall COS			
12. Judogi:	All competitors must have and use their own judogi - white and blue. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations, due to enforce the proper size and measurements of them as defined by the Competition Rules and fair conditions for athletes Sizes: Each athlete is responsible for his judogi to comply with the IJF Sokuteiki Rule. All competitors are obliged to have back number on their judogi.			
13. Judogis: Backnumbers	1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the. back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation. The CHANGEABLE bottom part is not obligatory for Junior European Cups and will not be provided by organizers of Cetniewo 2010. 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com Production and delivery takes around 4weeks. 3. The organizer will order enough backnumbers for all participants according to the numerical entry. Should the participating federation list more athletes than are actually participating, the federation will pay € 10 per extra athlete (2 back numbers at € 5 each). If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the name and country patch, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament. 14. Judogis:

Acceptable markings

As advised during the EJU Ordinary Congress 2010, the EJU decided to allocate the space on the shoulder stripes only to EJU official suppliers, for all official EJU Tournaments (starting from the 15th of February). The other advertising spaces, as allocated by the IJF, remain as before.

Therefore, Judogi with advertising of non-suppliers on shoulder stripes cannot be used. Judoka who like to compete must ensure that the Judogi conforms to these rules and therefore remove the non-EJU Official Supplier advertising or change the jacket. It is not allowed to tape or cover any non-authorized suppliers as this would affect the judogi design and the grip of the opponent.

As from the 15th of February, Judogi with shoulder adverts (strips) not from the approved list of suppliers will not be accepted. List of official suppliers you can find on: http://www.eju.net/sponsors-and-suppliers

Acceptable markings

- National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100 cm².
- Shoulder markings (from collar across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
- 3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.)

 Maximum size 20 cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved"

 Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm²)
- 4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.
- 5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Champion ships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
- 6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.

Teams will be met at Gdańsk International Airport, Gdynia Glowna Railway station (but not in Gdansk), Gdynia or Gdansk coming by ferries. Transportation inside Cetniewo (concerning the tournament) is included in the price.
