Entries by number should be made together with the final entries. Accommodation and meals are to be borne by the participating federations! See the information below. 8. Competition mode:	Competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the EJU: double repechage competition system (6 and more entries); 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 third match will decide; 3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin).			
	In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries.			
	Preliminaries – 3 mats (8 m x 8 m), Bronze medals fights – 2 mats (8 m x 8 m), Finals – 1 mat (8 m x 8 m)			
	Time of contest - 4 min, Golden Score-2 min.			
9. Weigh-in:	Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt.			
10. Refereeing: Special Rules for Cadets	Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition. Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.			
11. Referee:	All participating National Federations are kindly requested to bring at least one international referee to secure neutral refereeing: A or B or a candidate at IJF Referee.			
12. Referee meeting:	Saturday 22 nd May 2010 9:00 Sport Hall			
11. Judogi:	All competitors must have and use own judogi white and blue. Judogi control according to Sokuteiki rule. All competitors are obliged to have back number on their judogi.			
12. Judogis: Backnumbers	1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the. back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation. The CHANGEABLE bottom part is not obligatory for Cadet European Cups and will not be provided by organizers of Szczyrk 2010. 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com Production and delivery takes around 4weeks.			

Acceptable markings

Acceptable markings

- National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100 cm².
- 2. Shoulder markings (from collar across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
- 3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm²)
- 4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.
- 5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Champion ships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
- 6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.
