The competition system KO with quarterfinal (last 8) repechage. Seeding of the top 8 among entered competitors according to the World Ranking list. Remainder of the draw – separation by nations.

Judogis	Blue and white Judogi are obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteiki Rule approved by IJF from the 1 st January, 2009. All athletes must carry his/her surname on the back of their Judogi:			
	1. Each competitor taking part in the IJF events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation. 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. 3. The CHANGEABLE bottom part is optional and will not be provided by organizers of the 2 nd Chinggis Khan World Cup.			
Doping control	Two (2) competitors will have to undergo anti-doping test by each weight category: - the gold medalist, - one of the three other medalists (by draw)

International Training Camp Monday, 26 July Thursday, 29 July

International Training Camp will be organized from **26 to 29 July in the National Judo Training Centre in Ulaanbaatar**.

The cost of the training camp is **U\$ 300.00 per person**

Accommodation in **Hotel Bayangol,** inclusive full board, local transport hotel – training center, hotel – airport.

Two Randori training sessions per day, 80 plus Mongolian top judokas, men and women. Large dojo with 1000 m2 of tatami, sauna, massage other facilities.

Sightseeing on 26 July, travel to an attractive Terelj National park, 13th Century National Park and Chinggis Khan Village will be offered to all the TC participants.
