Judogi: Blue & White Judogi is obligatory, Judogi control according to Sokuteiki rule.

Back numbers: The Back Number is divided in 2 sections.

The top part of the back number consists of the Surname and Country of the athlete. Should the athlete report to the competition without the official licenced EJU

backnumber for Name and Country patch, the athlete will not be allowed to compete.


These back numbers can be ordered only from www.mybacknumber.com. It is important

to note that production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.

It is the duty of the participating federation / athlete to order this part of the back

number in time.

- 1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.
- 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.
- 3. The CHANGEABLE part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
- 4. The athletes must arrive at the competition hall with their back numbers already sewn on the judogi





Entries:

a) First entry

Federations are requested to inform the German Judo Federation whether they will participate in the tournament/training camp or not by prescribed entry form not later than **June 7**th **2010**.

b) Hotel entry

Reservations only written at latest of July 9th 2010, to German Judo Federation.

c) Final entry

Federations that want to participate in this tournament are requested to notify the German Judo Federation about all participants, age and weight category by prescribed form no later than **July 23**th **2010**.

d) Bank transfer

Payment has to be made until 23rd July 2010

If payment is made after 23th July 2010 a surcharge of 10% will be levied upon the total payable amount.

e) Travel schedule

The organizer cannot guarantee transfer from Hamburg airport or train station to the Hotel unless precise information with regard to arrival date and place is given until **July 26th 2010**.


