	2. Final Entry National Federations are required to complete the British Judo Association online inscription form by Friday 16 <sup>th</sup> September 2011 so all final team requirements can be confirmed with the official hotel. This must be completed via the CSE online booking tool.				
	All EJU / IJF member federations must pay to the EJU a fee of €10 per participant directly at point of accreditation/registration.

Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. As from the World Championships 2011 in Paris, all Judogi (Jacket, Trousers and Belt) must have the IJF Official Label with an IJF optical code. 


#### **Back Numbers**

All competitors must have the official EJU / IJF Back Number (ordered from www.mybacknumber.com). The sponsor part will be provided by the organisers during accreditation.

Competitors who still have the 2010 version of the Back Number will be allowed to compete in the EJU World Cups through 2011. From 1st January 2012, only the new version of the Back Number will be allowed.

If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.
