Refereeing The Refereeing will be according to the F.II.I/I.IF refereeing rules

The Refereeing will be according to the EJU/IJF refereeing rules. Special refereeing rules for cadets will be apply:







	 Application of Kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be not penalty. If torus applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition. Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.
