Participation: girls and boys from all EJU / IJF affiliated countries, born 1995 – 1996

Per weight category per nation up to 6 athletes may participate (Germany 24),

up to a total of 36 boys and 32 girls per nation (Germany 144/128).

Passports will be required at the weigh-in.

Weight categories: girls: -40 kg, -44 kg, -48 kg, -52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg

boys: -46 kg, -50 kg, -55 kg, -60 kg, -66 kg, -73 kg, -81 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg

Weigh-in: Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and

girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100 g will be allowed for their

weight category limits.

Weigh-in-venue: Unofficial and official weigh-in will take place at "Holiday Inn Berlin City East",

Landsberger Allee 203 in 13055 Berlin (700 m from the competition hall).

Holiday Inn offers buffet breakfast at a reduced prize of 11,00 €to all non-guests;

advance bookings can be made during accreditation.

Contest System: Double repechage competition system

Competition systems with low number of participants:

2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide 3, 4, 5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin).

6 and more entries: repechage competition system Time of contests: 4 min / Golden Score 2 min

Blue & White Judogi are obligatory, they have to fulfil the requirements of the EJU; Judogi control according to Sokuteiki rule!

Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition.

Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.

Refereeing: Each delegation should bring an IJF/ Continental license referee.

Referee's meeting will take place on Saturday, 07th of May at 09:00 h.

Entries: Nominal entries are to be sent to the German Judo Federation until March, 7th.



Registration Fee: €40,00 per registered Judoka to be paid cash before the official weigh-in.

Judogi: IJF Judogi is obligatory!

- 1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2010 EJU / IJF back number will only be accepted in European Cups until 31st December 2011.
- 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.
- 3. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
