Competitions rules	The Tournament will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF. The competition system KO with quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.  Seeding of the top 8 among entered competitors according to the World Ranking list. Remainder of the draw – separation by nations.
