PARTICIPATION

All IJF affiliated countries.

Top sportsmen of IJF Rate.

Each country may enter 4 competitors both men and women.

REFEREES

Referees are appointed by IJF.

COMPETITION RULES

Quarter Final repechage System.

PARTICULAR RULES FOR WOMEN

Female contestants shall wear under the jacket either, a plain white or off-white tee shirt, with short sleeves, rather strong, long enough to be worn inside the trousers, or a plain white or off-white leotard with short sleeves. All other regulations must be adhered to.













DURATION OF CONTESTS

MEN & WOMEN: Five (5) minutes (real time). The "Golden score" shall be three (3) minutes.

COACHING

Code of behavior of coaches as defined in the Sports and Organization Rules will be strictly observed.

Coaches

Position of coaches

Chairs for two coaches per each competition mat, for the blue and the white side, will be provided behind the barriers of advertising panels.

Code of Conduct for Coaches

The coach is responsible for his athlete's conduct from entering the competition venue until leaving it, before and after each contest.

Coaching will be strictly limited to communication with athlete, tactical advice, encouragements, instructions in unexpected situations, as injury... The coach will remain seated on his chair throughout the contest.

Forbidden behavior of a coach

Any comments on or criticism of the referees' verdicts.

Demanding correction of the referees' decisions.

Any abusive gesture toward referees, officials or public.

Touching, hitting, kicking... the advertising panels or any equipment.

Any kind of behavior showing disrespect to the opponent, referees, opponent coach, his own athlete, the public...

Dress Code

Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes.

For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.

The following are forbidden at any time: shorter trousers, undressed upper body, any kind of head caps and cover, jeans, sweaters or similar sports unrelated dress, flip-flops.

Penalizing

Any coach who infringes upon these rules will be disqualified from accompanying his athletes into competition zone and taking up coach's chair until the end of event.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be held after awarding ceremony.

The anti-doping control will include:

- 1. the winner of the category
- 2. one of the three other medal winners,
- 3. one of the 5th and 7th placed competitors

As per draw (for 2 & 3) carried out in accordance with the Anti-doping Rules and the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF.













The competitors have to report to the Doping Control Station not later than 60 min after signed Notification form, in writing by the Physician mandated by the IJF must follow the indications leading them to the check station. They are constantly accompanied by persons from the organization from the time they receive their notice until they reach the check station. A person of their choice (team doctor, coach, trainer, delegation head...) may accompany the competitors. The draw is made during the competition before the start of the finals block.

ACCREDITATION

1-2 athletes - 2 accreditations

3-5 athletes - 3 accreditations

6-8 athletes - 4 accreditations

The number of accreditations doesn't include sportsmen's accreditation and referred to delegation members only (coaches, doctors, physiotherapists, etc.)

Extra accreditation for delegation members will cost 100 € for 2 days.

ACCREDITATION CENTRE

The Accreditation Room will be open at the "Tyumen" Hotel, 27th October between 14h00 and 18h00 and 28th October between 10h00 and 12h00. An Accreditation Card with a photograph will be issued to IJF Officials, accredited National Federation, Officials and Media. This Accreditation Card should be carried at all times.

CONTROL OF ENTRIES OF THE ATHLETES

The Accreditation Room for the control of entries of the athletes will be open at the "Tyumen" Hotel, 27th October between 10h00 and 18h00 and 28th Octoberber between 10h00 and 18h00. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or photocopy of passport).

N.B.: the IJF Accreditation Card for competitors will be done during this control and will be given to Delegation Head.

DRAW

The Draw will take place on Friday 28th of October 2010 at 14h00 at the "Tyumen" Hotel, "Renaissance" Hall. The draw will be under the control and auspices of the IJF Sports Commission. Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the draw; a maximum of 2 delegates (The dress-code is formal: jacket and tie.) per National Federation will be authorized.













JUDOGI CONTROL

The Judogi Control will be under the control of the IJF Education & Coaches Director.

Advertising: Each national Federation must make sure that the marking and advertising placed on the Judogi is in conformity with the IJF rules. The use of a non-conforming Judogi will be prohibited.

Sizes: In order to enforce the proper size and measurements of judogi as defined by the Competition Rules and fair conditions for athletes, the IJF has approved the special measuring device SOKUTEIKI and a new procedure of judogi control, starting from 15th June 2011.

Color: Competitors will be required to bring white and blue judogi or reversible judogi.

The Color standards for the judogi must be in conformity with those in the Sports and Organization Rules: between pantone numbers, N° 18-4051 and N° 18-4039 on the pantone scale of TP and 285 or 286 for print.
