Technical Information

1. DATE

The competition will be held on Sunday 20th of February 2011.

2. PARTICIPATION

One competitor can only participate in two Kata. Couples can be composed of either 2 males, 2 females or a male and a female.

3. AGE & GRADE

Participants are to be 15 years of age and over the ranking of 1st Kyu,
Only participants from EJU / IJF member federations will be allowed. Local participants must have
FFBJ or VJB licence. A doctor's certificate less than a year old is required if it's in application in your
country. Without doctor's certificate the participants take part under their own responsibility.

4. KATA

The Kata recognised for these championships, will be five:

- Nage-no-kata
- Kime-no-kata
- Katame-no-kata
- Goshin-jitsu
- Ju-no-kata

5. INSCRIPTION

Nominal inscriptions The nominal inscriptions must be entered into FFBJ. The entry closes 10 days before the championships, **10**th **February 2011**.

The inscription fee is **20 Euro** per participating couple and per Kata, it has to be paid before **10th February 2011** at the:

FFBJ Regulations

All payments entered after the inscriptions deadline will be 30 Euro per competitor.

Once the inscription fee is paid it will not be refundable if the competitors fail to participate in the competition.





6. COMPETITION FORMULA

The top three pairs with the maximum points in every Kata, will compete in the finals. The pair with the maximum points / mistakes will be awarded the gold medal. The couple with the second least points / mistakes will be awarded the silver medal; and the third, the Bronze medal.

7. POINT SYSTEM

Points are awarded according to the EJU official score board. The Judges should take in consideration:

- Small mistakes (8 to 9 points)
- Medium mistakes (7 points)
- Big mistakes as well as wrong techniques (5 points)
- forgotten techniques(0 point)

The total points accumulated will be the final result.

8. FINAL

Till 6 participants direct final.

From 7 and upon 11 participants 1 preliminary and 4 best results to final

From 12 participants and more 2 preliminary and 3 best results of each to final (EJU/IJF) rules.

9. CLOTHING

The competitions will be held in white judogi.

Judogi Control:

- Clean judogi in good repair and of correct dimensions
- EJU Kata Championship back numbers on back of jacket can be used
- Zori or mules as part of the uniform

Long hair has to be bound with an elastic band.

Spectacles and jewellery are prohibited.

The nails have to be cut short.

The women competitors must wear a white non-transparent T-shirt, The bras must not have any hard pieces. Make-up is not allowed.

10. LEVEL OF THE JUDGES

The contests will be judged by IJF/EJU or National qualified Kata Judges. Kata rules to be followed are as published by the EJU. The Judges will evaluate these Kata on the basis of the official Kodokan Kata standard according and with reference to the official KdK edition of video (official amendment only should be considered if any)

11. SYSTEM OF JUDGING

Judge will award points on the official EJU scoring sheet. The Maximum points and the Minimum Points awarded are cancelled and the remaining three are totalled to get the final number of penalties. All of them should be coordinated by the Head Judges of the Belgian Kata Commission.
