Age	Minimum 15 years of age (born in 1997 or before)		
Competition Mode	The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJ and EJU. Competition system: An elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.		
Duration of contests	5 minutes and the Golden Score 3 minutes.		
Weigh-in	Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport (identity card in case of domestic athletes) at the official weigh-in. For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program		
Refereeing	<ul> <li>Each federation may enter 1 referee</li> <li>The organizing federation a maximum of 4 referees.</li> <li>Referees must be holding the IJF license A or B and with a valid classification A or B.</li> <li>A referee meeting will be held on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2012 at 19:00hrs at the Vitosha</li> <li>Park Hotel.</li> <li>The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.</li> </ul>		
Draw	Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest s of the draw – separation by nations.		
	The draw will take place on Friday at <u>20:00 hrs in Vitosha Park Hotel</u> . Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials.
