Participation	Age Category: born 1997 and before.  National representation: competitor can register and compete only for the country of which he/she holds the passport. In case of a federation or a club register an athlete with a different Nationality a confirmation letter from the Federation of the same Athlete's Nationality should be presented during the accreditation.  Jumas: according to EJU rules, Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday of the week of the Tournament. Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. Competition System	Double repechage competition system. Competition systems with low number of participants:  • 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide  • 3,4,5 entries: round robin competition system  • 6 and more entries: repechage competition system
Award Money	There is a 1000€ award money for the winner of each category. The minimum number of participants per weight category should be 8 competitors. If there is less, the award is 500€. If there is less than 4 competitors there will be no award money.

Competition Entry Fee	Entry for Swedish Judo Open is 60€ per participant including lunch during the competition.
Special Offer	For current world and Olympic medallists no entry fee and free accommodation will be offered during the competition.

Accommodation during	Accommodation should only be booked through Borås Judo Clubs Hotel reservation form. When the official hotel is fully booked the organizer will make reservations in other hotels and inform the delegations.

	All payments are to be made through bank transfer. Cash payments at the venue will be charged 10 € extra per participant as an administration fee. All expenses prepaid by bank transfer will be refunded if the competitor cannot participate.
Travel Costs and Visa	All the travel costs to Sweden and back as well as Visa costs should be taken care of by the participating country/club. The organizer will send an invitation for visa arrangements on request.
	The visa applications should be left either to the Swedish Embassy or other authorized Schengen area Embassy at least 4-6 weeks before the date of final entry.

Official Accreditation/ Draw	Thursday 25" of October at the official accreditation, we will check that the registrations of the competitors are valid. And make sure that all payments are correct.  Only coaches will have access to the accreditation room. On Thursday, the official accreditation day, will the draw be made for the whole competition.  Seeding of the top 4 competitors in each weight category according to the EJU seniors RL. In case there are 2 athletes from the same country in the top 4, the athletes will be separated by nation.  Draw: The draw for all weight categories will be held on Thursday evening at 21.00.  EJU / IJF Dress Code: jacket suit with tie

Absence during the official Accreditation	We strongly recommend all the coaches to arrive during the accreditation day, Thursday 25 <sup>th</sup> October, and to be present at the draw.  If you as coach, for any reason, will not be able to attend at the official accreditation before the draw, you have to contact us during the accreditation day on +46 737 25 70 76 before 20.00 and register all your competitors otherwise the competitor's registration will be annulled.
Unofficial Accreditation	<i>Friday 26</i> <sup>th</sup> of October there will be an unofficial accreditation at Hotel Plaza for late arrivals from 12.00-18:00. If you intend to arrive on Friday and your coach will not participate on the official accreditation, don't forget that your coach must make the compulsory accreditation phone call during, Thursday 25 <sup>th</sup> before 20:00 of October, otherwise the competitors registration will be annulled and cannot be considered at the draw.
Coaches	All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Forbidden is coaching throughout the contest except for between Matte and Hajime. (the coach is only allowed to speak to his athlete between Matte and Hajime)  *Dress Code*: Jacket, suit and tie are expected to be worn by the coaches for the draw and the final blocks.
Referees	The IJF A/B referees will be classified during the tournament by EJU Referee Commission members. Participating countries may enter an IJF / Continental Licensed referee.
Airport transfer	The airport transfer will be organized by the Organising Committee as long as you arrive at Gothenburg City Airport (1 hour away from the competition venue) or Landvetter Airport (30 minutes away from the competition venue).
Insurance	Every competitor must have an international insurance for injuries.
Liability	Neither the organizer of the event, nor Borås Judo Club or the Swedish Judo Federation (not any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with the Swedish Judo Open 2012.

#### Transfers to Finland

Borås Judo Club will organize transfer to our friends in Finland and the Judo Finnish Open 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> of November. Travel arrangements will be provided at cost, about 80€ per person. The transfer fee includes a one way bus and ferry ticket to Helsinki. The organizer for Finnish Open will take over from there.


Remember to send us your birthdates for the transfer to Finland. We need them for the ferry booking. Year/month/day.

#### Judogi

Blue and white Judogi is compulsory. All Judokas must compete in IJF Approved Judogi and the Judogi will be controlled according to Sokuteki rule.

- 1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number.
- 2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <a href="https://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judogi will be available
- 3. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
