Participation requirements	 Age Category: age 15 & 16 (born 1996 - 1997) All EJU / IJF affiliated countries In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision. If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned. According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday of the week of the Tournament. Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. Jumas website : https://jumas12.net/user/login
<mark>WEIGH IN</mark> 	 Weigh In for each weight category shall be held on the same day as the competition. Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100g will be allowed for their weight category limits. At least 2 (two) hours shall be provided between the end of the official, weigh-in and start of the competition Athletes must present accreditation card and passport or national identity card with photo 06:30- 07:00 h. Un Official weight-in. 07:00- 07:30 h. Official weight-in.



- Numerical Inscriptions must be sent in about 2 months before. The participating federation should advise how many athletes will be participating.
- Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number.
- The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <u>www.mybacknumber.com</u>. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available.
- The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.

	Each delegation should bring an IJF/ Continental license referee.
Refereeing	 The Refereeing will be according to the EJU/IJF refereeing rules. Special refereeing rules for cadets will be apply: Application of Kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be not penalty. If torus applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition. Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.
Liability	Neither the organizers of the event, nor the Royal Spanish Judo Federation (or any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to any property arising out of participations and travelling in connection with these championships.
