Participation	All EJU / IJF Member Federations.  No limit of participation per category per country.  Age category: Minimum 15 years of age (born 1997 or before).  Competitor can register and compete only for the country of which he/she holds the passport.  In case a Federation or a club registers an athlete with a different Nationality, a confirmation letter from the National Federation of the country of which the Athlete holds the passport should be presented during the accreditation.

	The organizer will provide transfers between the Tampere airport or railway station and official hotel – and between official hotel and competition venue. Transportation will be offered only to those participants who are accomodated in the official hotel.  Participating national federations are responsible for their own travel to the Tampere, Finland.		
Accreditation Control of entries	Accreditation will take place on Friday 10:00 to 18:00 in Hotel Scandic Rosendahl.		
	At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on 21 <sup>st</sup> September from 10:00 to 18:00 in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or photocopy of passport).		
Draw	Seeding of the top 4 competitors in each weight category according to the EJU Senior RL. In case there are 2 athletes from the same country in the top 4, the athletes will be separated by nation.		
	The draw will take place on Friday 20:00 in Hotel Scandic Rodendahl.		
	Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials. Dress code: jacket suit with tie.		
Weigh-in	Athletes must present their EJU accreditation and passport at the official Weigh-In. For time and place of the Weigh-In see the Program.		
Refereeing	Each delegation should bring an IJF / Continental licensed referee.  A referee meeting will be held on Friday 21 <sup>st</sup> September at 19:00 at the Hotel Scandic Rosendahl.		
Competition mode and duration of contests	The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU.  - Double repechage competition system.  - 5 minutes and the Golden Score 3 minutes.  - Competition systems with less than 5 competitors will be played in Round Robin:  Competition systems with low number of participants:  - 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide  - 3,4,5 entries: round robin competition system  - 6 and more entries: repechage competition system. Entry Fee	An entry fee of 30€ per athlete.		
Jumas According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is 17th September 2012. Participants without a v EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. Jumas membership must then be ordered through the federation. ## All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Forbidden Coaching is coaching throughout the contest except for between Matte and Hajime (the coach is only allowed to speak to his athlete between Matte and Hajime). Dress Code: In Draw jacket suit and tie, in Elimination rounds national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or Jacket suit with Tie. In Final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie. Judogi Blue & White Judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule. All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website. **Back Numers** Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2012 EJU / IJF back number. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
