You boldly look for the development of both athlete and program, in order to achieve an optimal result at Olympic level together with the team of NTC coaches.

Main tasks and responsibilities:

- The sports technical development of judokas in the transition phase between talent academy and Olympic level;
- Provide training and coaching during international tournaments at European Open and Grand Prix level;
- Provide direction to an interdisciplinary supervision team;
- Develop and support the vision of women's judo;
- Gather, develop and share knowledge in the field of sports technology;
- Contribute to competence development of the team of NTC coaches.

Job requirements:

- Experience as a competition judoka and/or coach at an international level;
- Pedagogical, didactic and communication skills appropriate for young athletes;
- Ambitious and development-oriented;
- Determined, flexible and stress resistant;
