You are flexible in terms of working hours and location. Independent working style, reliability and age- and culture-appropriate supervision of children are a "must".

- Long-term development of the judo youth scene in Liechtenstein according to the objectives of the LJF.
- Execution of trainings substituting the regular school sports lessons.
- Conducting judo trainings over the lunch break, after school or special judo courses during school vacations.
- Assisting with daily judo instruction at the Liechtenstein Sports School.
- Promoting and maintaining constructive and close contact with the clubs, the Liechtenstein Sports School, primary school teachers, parents and the authorities.
- Collaboration on specific projects such as the creation of concepts.
