You are flexible in terms of working hours and location. Independent working style, reliability and age- and culture-appropriate supervision of athletes are a "must".

- Organization, management and execution of the daily judo training at the Liechtenstein Sports School.
- Representation of the LJF in Liechtenstein and abroad as national coach. Promotion and maintenance of a constructive and close contact towards the clubs, the Liechtenstein Sports School and the authorities.
- Administrative tasks for the short, medium and long term planning of the national squad.
- Collaboration on specific projects such as the creation of concepts.
